#### Deferred Action for **Childhood Arrivals**

Although the recent decision to rescind DACA is devastating, remember the facts!

- Your DACA is valid until its expiration date.
- 2. No new DACA applications will be accepted.
- 3. DACA issuances and work permits expiring between now and March 5, 2018 must be submitted for renewal by October 5, 2017.
- 4. Advance parole to travel abroad is no longer available.

Through this Naturalization Course you will be guided through the entire application as you compile the necessary documents, you will receive study material, and you will have the opportunity to ask attorneys any questions regarding you natu-
